

Bartending Service Agreement of the Rotary Club of Paradise

If approved the Rotary Club of Paradise (RCP) agrees to provide bartending services for the event listed above. RCP will supply the liquor license, alcohol, soft drink, water, wrist bands, drink tickets, and disposable drink containers. The RCP will not supply coffee, tea or other complementary (non-fee) beverages. The RCP will provide the bartenders and will be responsible for the set-up and take-down of the bar supplies and equipment. Set up and take down of tables and decorations are the responsibility of the Requesting Organization (RO).

RCP will determine the pricing and the type of drinks sold. RO may request drink types. If so, items requested and not in RCP's inventory will be invoiced at full bottle prices regardless of how much is used and remains the property of RCP

All drink purchases will be made through a drink ticket system. The RCP will provide the tickets, cash drawer and change. Drink tickets will be purchased at a separate location from the bar. Each ticket will have a value of \$1.00. Drink tickets will then be used to purchase drinks. No cash transactions will occur at the bar. Staffing for ticket sales is the sole responsibility of the RO.

RO will hold the RCP, its Directors, members, agents and representatives, free from all liability and claims which may result from the bar services provided. It is the exclusive responsibility of the RO to monitor excessive alcohol consumption of all guests and to ensure alternative transportation is available when and if necessary.

RO will turn over all cash to RCP at the conclusion of the event. The RO will receive from the RCP one-third (33%) of the gross receipts. The remaining two-thirds (67%) of the gross receipts will be used by RCP to cover the bartending expenses. If there is any remaining net revenue, it will be retained by RCP to continue it's service to the community.
